Second Collection Next Weekend

The second collection next weekend will benefit Peter's Pence, the annual collection for the Holy Father's charitable giving. The Peter's Pence Collection has raised nearly \$190 million to support our suffering brothers and sisters around the globe. Thank you for standing in solidarity with the Holy See through your generosity. Please continue to pray for our brothers and sisters in faith who are facing adversity.

Climate Corner

The Vatican's May 2015 climate change summit released the following declaration: "Human induced climate change is a scientific reality, and its decisive mitigation is a moral and religious imperative for humanity." You are invited to consider how you might help mitigate the effects of climate change. A few suggestions include:

- Adjust your thermostat. Moving your thermostat down just 2 degrees in winter or up 2 degrees in summer can save 2 thousand pounds of carbon dioxide a year.
- Drive less. walk, bike, carpool or take mass transit more often. We save one pound of carbon dioxide for every mile we drive.
- Use less hot water. Takes a lot of energy to heat water. Use less hot water by installing a low flow showerhead (350 pounds of CO2 saved per year) and wash clothes in cold or warm water (500 pounds saved per year)
- Plant a tree. An average tree will absorb one ton of carbon dioxide over its lifetime.

From the Pastor's Desk

Today's column was written by Fr. Sam Sawyer, SJ, Associate Pastor at Holy Trinity.

Jerome Nadal, who had been delegated by Ignatius to travel to various Jesuit communities to help pass on the charism of the order in the early days, would remind Jesuits that we are not monks, that "our home is the road." Well, when I move to New York on July 1, it will be the sixth major city I've lived in in just over 11 years, and (counting only stays of a month or longer) I will be living in my 22nd different room as a Jesuit.

But that is not the most challenging part. I've gotten fairly good at moving, and Jesuit communities are likewise good at absorbing newcomers. The more difficult move – always – is saying goodbye to friends and communities that I've come to love. Holy Trinity, as you won't be surprised to hear, has made that part of the move even more difficult than it might normally be.

As many of you know, I am moving to New York City to start a new assignment as the associate editor for platform development for *America* magazine, along with some responsibilities at St. Ignatius Church on Park Ave. ("Platform development," being translated, means a focus on the website and other digital platforms for distributing *America's* content.) This is a great assignment, and I'm very grateful that my provincial was willing to make me available for it – it combines the interests I have in evangelization and communication with my skills in technology and my experience from helping to found *The Jesuit Post*, and it comes at an exciting time as *America* goes through a period of revitalization.

Really, the only downside is that it comes after such a short time at Holy Trinity. While I always knew that my assignment here in Georgetown would have a limited timeframe, it was never intended as – and it certainly hasn't been – a placeholder. As my first full-time pastoral assignment as a newly ordained priest, this parish community has been an integral part of forming me as a minister. You've helped me learn how to pray and preach with greater joy and faith, and I've learned from you new ways to pay attention to God at work within the life of a community.

That experience is one that many Jesuits have had at Holy Trinity, as the parish has hosted so many newly ordained priests over the years. As I've been at province gatherings and meetings, many other Jesuits have made a point to ask me about my time at Holy Trinity and to share stories from their first years of priesthood here, which is a pattern I fully expect to repeat in the future.

So, as I begin to make my goodbyes, let me also take this opportunity to say thank you. I'm grateful to my colleagues on the parish staff, and to all the volunteers, especially in liturgy and music ministry, who help to make Trinity such a wonderful place to worship. I'm also particularly grateful to have had the chance to build relationships within the Young Adult Community, with RCIA, and working with the Ignatian Spirituality programs.

But more than anything else, I'm grateful to God for the opportunity, Sunday after Sunday, to look out from the altar and ask God to "listen graciously to the prayers of this family, whom you have summoned before you." You have all helped me learn how true those words are, which is a gift I will carry forward through my priesthood.
