

William D. Dinges is an Ordinary Professor of Religious Studies in the School of Theology and Religious Studies and a fellow of the Institute for Policy Research and Catholic Studies at The Catholic University of America. He received his Ph.D. in American Studies in 1983 from the University of Kansas and has been on the faculty at Catholic University for the past thirty-two years.

Dr. Dinges has taught a course on God, Ethics, and the Environment for the past twenty-eight years. He is a member of the steering committee of the Catholic Climate Covenant, founder of St. John the Baptist Catholic Church Eco-Ministry group, and a member of the Washington

Archdiocesan Environmental Outreach Committee.
