

SERVICE OF THE FAITH

Holy Trinity serves approximately 3,500 registered households-more than 10,000 persons-from DC, Northern Virginia and Maryland. More than 600 parishioners serve as liturgical volunteers. In one year, our parish celebrates around 50 weddings, 200 infant baptisms and 35 funerals. Approximately 140 children celebrate their First Eucharist, 120 are confirmed, and RCIA prepares an average of 10 adults to be baptized or enter into full communion each year. We teach and promote the practice of Ignatian Spirituality. Approximately 200 individuals at Holy Trinity and beyond take part in Ignatian Spirituality programs.

PROMOTION OF JUSTICE

Holy Trinity tithes for social justice by dedicating 10% of our ordinary income to our Social Justice ministry. Since 2006, Holy Trinity has contributed more than \$3 million to over 70 agencies and organizations providing a variety of direct services to individuals challenged by low income and other disparities. Holy Trinity families have given countless hours of volunteer service to community organizations.


Holy Trinity offers one of the largest Religious Education (RE) and Faith Formation programs in the metropolitan Washington area. In the past year, we have enrolled over 700 children in the RE program, which includes Shepherd's Flock, a pioneering program for students with physical or learning challenges.

Founded in 1818, Holy Trinity School (HTS) is one of the few coeducational elementary schools in the Jesuit tradition in the United States. The school serves more than 340 racially, ethnically, and socioeconomically diverse children in pre-kindergarten through eighth grade. Nearly \$670,000 in need-based tuition assistance is distributed annually. HTS was awarded the National Blue Ribbon of Excellence by the Department of Education in 2016, and was named a Washington Post Top Workplace in 2017.


