

Rite of Reconciliation

Greeting: Hello Father. I am here to make my confession.

Begin with the Sign of the Cross: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

We confess our sins: The focus is on what leads us to step away from Jesus' love?

The priest gives us a penance to pray or do.

The priest asks us to say we're sorry: the child says an Act of Contrition or other prayer of sorrow.

The priest gives us absolution: "I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." The child says: **AMEN.**
