Deliver messages and conduct intakes with recently detained immigrants. Spanish recommended, but not required. Limited English only volunteer spots.

## For CAIR Coalition's Detention Hotline

### Who will be calling?

Volunteers will receive calls from detained immigrants in Maryland and Virginia, some of whom are asylum seekers, parents of US citizens, and people who are bond eligible.



### Why is the hotline so important?

The CAIR Coalition hotline is essential because in many cases it is the only means by which detained immigrants can contact us, their attorneys, or other organizations that can help with their cases. In fact, the CAIR Coalition legal access hotline is the only means that detained immigrants in Maryland can communicate with CAIR Coalition attorneys and staff.



### What does the job involve?

Volunteers will transfer calls to pro bono or private attorneys, complete phone intakes for recently arriving detainees, and deliver information written by our staff attorneys.
