



## HOLY TRINITY HEALTH & SAFETY COVENANT

As we open the campus on July 31 for a Feast of St. Ignatius Mass and enter Phase 2 (sacramental celebrations) on August 16, our first priority is the health and safety of our community. The risks of COVID-19 are evident to all. As parishioners for others, our mission calls each of us at this time to bear individual responsibility to help protect the health and safety of the entire community. Recognizing this responsibility, and in order to be present at church and the campus, we ask that you commit to the terms of this covenant:

I commit to the following:

Commitment to the health and safety of all. I will do my part to limit the spread of COVID-19 by making my own health and safety and that of others a priority. I will be mindful that the actions I take, both on and off campus, can help to limit the spread of COVID-19 to others in our community, including the most vulnerable.

Commitment to follow Holy Trinity's COVID-19 health and safety measures while on parish property. These measures currently include but are not limited to the following:

- Following District of Columbia, Maryland or Virginia (as appropriate) isolation and quarantine protocols;
- Practicing good personal hygiene consistently, including:
  1. Maintaining 6' of physical distancing between myself and any other person outside of my immediate family;
  2. Suggested hand hygiene (i.e. 20 second hand washing);
  3. Frequent use of hand sanitizers; and
  4. Wearing a face covering over my nose and mouth at all times.

I have read the information regarding [COVID-19](#) and understand that COVID-19 poses a serious threat to my health and safety, that Holy Trinity is taking many steps to mitigate the risks to members of our community, but that it is not possible to guarantee a COVID-19-free environment or eliminate the chance of infection and the health risks associated with it.

I understand that failure to follow Holy Trinity's guidelines could endanger myself or others and that I may be required to leave the Church and campus for not complying with any of the measures.

I commit to this covenant, compelled to be a parishioner for others and with a sense of shared responsibility to the safety and health of the Holy Trinity community and the community at large.
