

#### KEY SURVEY RESEARCH FINDINGS

The results of this comprehensive survey of Holy Trinity members coalesce into six major themes:

- 1. The centrality of the worship experience, with strong satisfaction with the Mass and Liturgies today, and a healthy desire by many to support the ministries of worship.
- **2.** A strong focus on social justice, which emerged as the leading area of personal interest by members, and their top three-to-five-year priority for the Parish.
- 3. The importance of building connections and a stronger sense of community within the Parish, which recurred perhaps more than any other issue, particularly among younger and newer members, and those who do not feel strongly connected to Holy Trinity today.

### KEY SURVEY RESEARCH FINDINGS

The results of this comprehensive survey of Holy Trinity members coalesce into six major themes:

- **4. The priority of engaging youth and embracing diversity**, which seems to be reflected both in a concern about the aging of the congregation, as well as a spiritual imperative to reach out and welcome more diverse members of the community.
- **5.** A focus on the role of women within the church, which is one of the highest three-to-five-year priorities for the Parish, and which is advanced almost as much by men at Holy Trinity as by women.
- **6. A hunger for spiritual growth and education**, reflected in expressed interest in spiritual ministries and parishioners' own spiritual development.

### **SWOT HIGHLIGHTS - STRENGTHS**

- Cutting edge, progressive, innovative, inclusive and very strong sense of community (rated the 2nd most positive aspect of Holy Trinity experience)
- Focus on Ignatian spirituality and sponsored by the Jesuits and the four core principles of missionary outreach, social ministry, collaboration in mission, and a practical spirituality through the Spiritual Exercises and Discernment
- Long history of the parish founded in 1791
- Location in the vibrant Georgetown area with ease of access from Northern Virginia and opportunities to partner with Georgetown University
- Current Holy Trinity staff are committed to the mission, passionate, and engaged
- Importance Holy Trinity places on the role of women in the church; women that serve as volunteers and paid staff
- Parishioners are active, talented, educated and engaged
- A highly-respected and successful Blue-Ribbon Pre-K through 8th Grade school

### SWOT HIGHLIGHTS - WEAKNESSES

- Location/parking/construction, etc.
- Diversity lacking in parishioners (cited as the second most pressing need of HT)
- Engagement with the neighborhood could be greater
- Web site needs refresh (only 25% thought it was a very effective means of communication)
- Communication/Marketing (internal and external)
- Need stronger culture of welcoming/hospitality
- Aging congregation and more needs to be done for the elderly (cited by 81% as very high or highest priority)
- Not enough focus on the environment (cited by 45% as very high or highest priority)
- Limited ability to be nimble and respond quickly to changes in the Holy Trinity community and beyond

### SWOT HIGHLIGHTS - OPPORTUNITIES

- Using technology to improve all aspects of the Holy Trinity experience
- Further involving Georgetown University campus community in Holy Trinity and HT in the campus activities
- Creating more partnerships in community/nationally/globally. More specifically, fully engaging and developing a stronger partnership with the Archdiocese of Washington
- Positioning Holy Trinity and ministry in concert with Pope Francis and the strategic initiatives of the broader Jesuit order
- Planned giving on the rise as population ages and moves into retirement
- Holy Trinity open to all how to capitalize on the growing role of women in the church and the LGBTQ+ community
- Expanding our engagement with the young adult community

- Social trends away from organized religion
- Recent issues within the Catholic Church and movement away from certain policies of the Church
