

HOLY TRINITY CATHOLIC CHURCH CONFIRMATION GUIDELINES 2024-2025

The sacrament of Confirmation unites us more closely to Christ, increases the gifts of the Holy Spirit in us, and therefore, equips us to witness more fully to our Catholic faith (cf. CCC 1303). "Preparation for Confirmation should aim to lead the Christian toward a more intimate union with Christ and a more lively familiarity with the Holy Spirit...in order to be more capable of assuming the apostolic responsibilities of the Christian life" (CCC 1309).

To reach these goals, we invite you to commit wholeheartedly to the following:

- > Participate in Mass weekly either on Saturday evenings or Sundays
- Attend faith formation classes regularly (through a Holy Trinity faith formation program, Holy Trinity School, or another Catholic School)
- ➢ Serve others
 - o Submit service proposal form by November 24, 2024
 - Complete four service projects (2-3 hours each)
 - At least one project must serve a vulnerable group of people
 - Complete service reflection by April 13, 2025
- > Pray daily
- Celebrate the Sacrament of Penance & Reconciliation before confirmation

Other Information

- ▶ Registration for Confirmation Due by November 3, 2024
- ▶ Baptismal certificate Submit by November 3, 2024
- Confirmation sponsor Submit sponsor form by November 17, 2024
 - Sponsors must be at least 16 years old and have celebrated all three sacraments of
 initiation: baptism, confirmation, and Eucharist. The sponsor should practice his/her
 Catholic faith in order to be a witness to living as a disciple of Christ and to help support
 the candidate. A parent may not be a sponsor for his/her child; a parent can serve as a
 proxy if the sponsor is unable to attend the confirmation.
- Confirmation Kick-off December 8 or 15, 2024, Time TBD (tentative)
 - o More information will be provided once details are finalized.
- Retreat in Daily Life various dates January March 2025
 - This retreat has an opening and closing session in person. During the week between the two sessions, candidates are invited to pray daily using an Ignatian way of praying.
- Confirmation name Submit confirmation name form by February 23, 2025
 - The Church does not have any specific rule regarding choosing a name for Confirmation. You may use your baptismal name, your given name that was spoken aloud when you were baptized. This shows the connection between baptism and confirmation. You also may choose the name of a saint or blessed whose life inspires you to live as a disciple of Jesus.
- Reflection on Discipleship & the Holy Spirit Submit reflection by March 16, 2025
- > What to wear
 - All candidates will wear a rented gown at confirmation; these will be handed out on May 11 when we gather before Mass.
 - 0 For ladies a nice dress (knee length; shoulders covered) or nice pants & shirt
 - For gentlemen shirt & tie; dress pants
