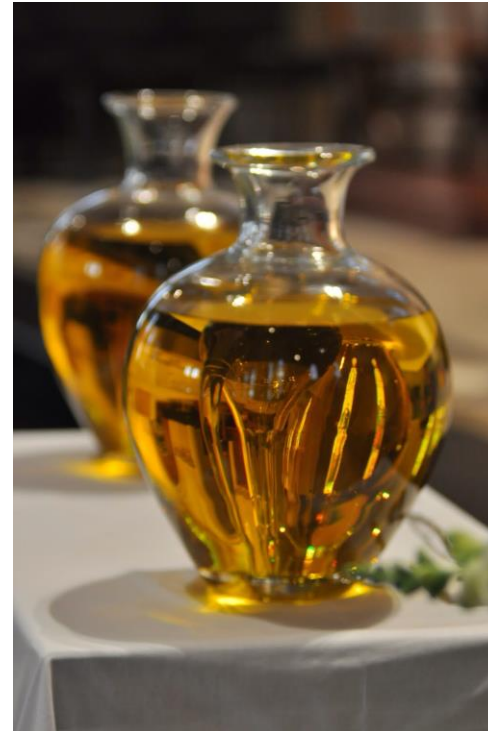

Confirmation

*And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate – to be with you always, the Spirit of truth. The Advocate, the holy Spirit that the Father will send in my name—he will teach you everything and remind you of all that [I] told you.

- Confirms what happens at Baptism
- Celebrates the Holy Spirit in our lives
- Effects
 - Unites us more firmly to Christ
 - Increases the gifts of the Holy Spirit within us
 - Makes our bond with the Church more perfect
 - Gives us special strength of the Holy Spirit to live out our faith both in our actions and our words
